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Perfecting Pratas

The narrative preamble to the play was a great introduction to dramaturgy for students and we really enjoyed how the many seemingly abstract notions of theatre was practically manifested for students to experience and bring back to the classroom in their further reading of the play. When a director decides to stage Perfecting Pratas, he runs into a host of problems: the uncle he hired can't remember his lines, the other young actor can't get into character, and they're missing the whole point of his play!

As the actors talk it out and work on different exercises to perfect their performance, the audience will get to learn about the fundamentals of drama including characterisation, intention, motivation, obstacles which will give a deeper understanding to the reading of Perfecting Pratas.

The play was relatable to students using project group work as the premise to bring in notable moments from the text. Students were also challenged with questions and ideas raised during the performance which would allow them to have a more vibrant discussion in their classrooms. Four JC students are forced to work together on a project about The Boy on the Striped Pajamas. But when tempers flare and history start to repeat itself, the four students must learn to embody the message of the book, or risk failing the entire class.

Though the barbed-wire fence of the camp separates 9 year-old Bruno and his Jewish friend, Shmuel, the boys begin a forbidden friendship, oblivious to the real nature of their surroundings...

> From a directorial lens, Derrick gave wonderful insights into both the text and film. Students were encouraged to uncover the layers of subtexts and unpack the complexity of characters under Derrick's direction in the drama enactment activity. Even the teachers have been inspired by the activities which we will readily adopt in our class!

The film follows the story of an elderly mother battling to preserve her home and community as residents are coerced into a collective housing block sale and the ensuing conflict with her son who desires a fresh start.

This updated adaptation of Singaporean playwright, Jean Tay's 2007 stage play is a poignant tribute to the disappearing heritage sites of Singapore, beautifully captured in the film's charming and bittersweet visuals.

In this 2 day workshop, we unpack the underlying themes, characterisation, staging concepts and dramatic meanings in BOOM by helping students and teachers alike sensitize themselves to the play as a theatrical form/genre and the processes of theatre-making.

Through acting activities directed and facilitated by our director, we introduce a theatre practitioner's perspective and help students access the inner thoughts of the characters and their wants and how it contribute to the dramatic trajectory in terms of plot and action which will deepen their understanding of the play in the process.

The workshop helped students visualise and understand how to interpret the play from the perspective of a theatre practitioner. The highlight was when Derrick directed specific scenes with the students and taught them about character motivations and how to portray those on stage. This experience was not only engaging and unforgettable, but also beneficial to students as it deepened their understanding of the characters, beyond words on a printed page.
