Perfect entry play for students curious about drama! The staging elements were so well planned and are brilliant at helping students visualise what they cannot in a classroom - huge bonus for helping them break out of just reading.

SHOW: PERFECTING PRATAS

It was a wonderful opportunity to get the students excited about the text they are reading and going to a theatre to watch it come to life. From their positive reactions during the play, it is quite evident that it was an enjoyable experience. For some of them, it might be their first time watching a play at a theatre.

Even though my students are not studying Shakespeare in school, it's crucial for them to be exposed to Shakespeare and this was the perfect opportunity. The introduction at the start to highlight the literary devices that are so beautifully weaved into the text was great!

The workshop helped students visualise and understand how to interpret the play from the perspective of a theatre practitioner. The highlight was when Derrick directed specific scenes with the students and taught them about character motivations and how to portray those on stage. This experience was not only engaging and unforgettable, but also beneficial to students as it deepened their understanding of the characters, beyond words on a printed page.
